Greetings L/P fans!

We want to let you know some information in regards to our upcoming fall sports seasons. As you may already know, our football and volleyball teams are able to play this fall. Like everything else these days, this comes with restrictions. The following is to the best of our knowledge what is happening with these sports.

Football

1. We are allowed to have up to 250 spectators at a game. There will be an allotment of 150 tickets for the home team and 100 for the away team.
2. All tickets will be pre-sold during the week of each game.
3. We are giving out student-athletes the first option to purchase up to 3 tickets for away games and up to 4 for home games. This will be done prior to any tickets being made available to the public.
4. Any unsold tickets from the players will be made available to the public to be sold at either Pacelli or Lyle Schools on Tuesday of each week.
 - a. Lyle Public School: Tickets will be sold between the hours of 4-6pm.
 - b. Pacelli High School: Tickets sold during the school day.
5. All tickets will be \$6. There is no discount for students and senior citizens. Season passes will also not be available this season.
6. The away team each week will have until the day before the game to sell their allotment. All unsold tickets will be turned over to the host team to sell the day of the game not to exceed the 250 person maximum.
7. We are looking into streaming these games live. We will communicate when we have more information.
8. There will be additional restrictions for spectators at football games. We are working with area schools and the MSHSL to confirm these restriction. Stay tuned for further information.

Volleyball

1. Due to Minnesota State High School League and Minnesota Department of Health guidelines. Spectators will not be allowed in at any volleyball event.
2. We are looking into streaming these games live. We will communicate when we have more information.

We thank you in advance for understanding the situation that we are dealt with. We want the season to be a success. The health of all our participants is #1.
